The campaign for a new magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) scanner.

The MRI suite at Mercy Medical Center performed 3,000 MRI exams in 2020. Our current MRI scanner was installed in 2010 and while it is still serviceable, the new version has a wider bore diameter (27.5 inches compared to our current 23 inches).

The addition will allow greater patient comfort, the ability to accommodate larger patients, and the ability to offer MRI breast imaging.

- Larger bore accommodates more patients with less claustrophobia.
- Newer imaging technology produces clearer images with additional diagnostic information.

Having a second scanner for outpatient, emergency, and inpatient services will reduce utilization conflicts resulting in more efficient, higher-quality patient care.
